BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATHS BA17/1 AND BA17/3, NEWTON ST LOE) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2020

On 11th March 2021 the Bath and North East Somerset Council confirmed the above order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert that section of public footpath:

- FP BA17/1 running from grid reference ST 7033 6568 (point E on Part 1 of the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally north northeasterly direction for approximately 10 metres to a junction with FP BA17/3 at grid reference ST 7033 6569 (point C) to a new line running from grid reference ST 7033 6568 (point E) and proceeding in a generally north northwesterly direction for approximately 235 metres to a junction with FP BA17/3 at grid reference ST 7013 6579 (point F);
- FP BA17/3 running from grid reference ST 7007 6580 (point A on Part 1 of the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally easterly direction for approximately 115 metres to grid reference ST 7017 6582 (point B) and turning in a generally southeasterly direction for approximately 232 metres to grid reference ST 7033 6569 (point C) and turning in a generally north northeasterly direction for approximately 243 metres to grid reference ST 7040 6590 (point D) to a new line running from grid reference ST 7007 6580 (point A) and proceeding in a generally easterly direction for approximately 69 metres to a junction with FP BA17/1 at grid reference ST 7013 6579 (point F) and turning in a generally east to grid reference ST 7040 6590 (point D); and
- FP BA17/3 running from grid reference ST 7142 6602 (point G on Part 2 of the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally east southeasterly direction for approximately 245 metres to grid reference ST 7163 6591 (point H) and turning in a generally southerly direction for approximately 118 metres to grid reference ST 7164 6579 (point J) to a new line running from grid reference ST 7142 6602 (point G) and proceeding in a generally east southeasterly direction for approximately 217 metres to grid reference ST 7160 6592 (point K) and turning in a generally south southeasterly direction for approximately 133 metres to grid reference ST 7164 6579 (point J),

as shown on the order map.

The order came into force on 18th March 2021 but if any person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from the date of this notice, make an application to the High Court.
