PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY CONSULTATION

Bath and North East Somerset Council are proposing to make alterations to the Public Rights of Way network at the south of Keynsham

Bath and North East Somerset Council are consulting on a proposal to widen and upgrade a public footpath to a public bridleway. The route runs from a junction with Newlands Road at Point A on Plan 1 in a generally southerly direction for approximately 175 metres to a junction with a new estate road at Point D; this route is shown by a broken green line on Plan 1. The school fence will be moved back and the route will be 3.5 metre wide between points A and B, between 3 metres and 4.3 metres wide between points B and C and 3 metres wide between points C and D. The proposal to upgrade the route to a bridleway is to allow cyclists, including pupils attending Castle Primary School, to cycle between the new The Meadows (K2) housing development and the pre-existing areas of Keynsham to the north.
