BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATHS BA15/27 AND BA15/35, HUNSTRETE, MARKSBURY) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2019

On 14th November 2019 Bath and North East Somerset Council confirmed the above order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert:

- 1. that section of public footpath running from a junction with Hunstrete Lane and Public Footpath BA15/35 at grid reference ST 6478 6235 (point A on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally southerly direction for approximately 142 metres to grid reference ST 6477 6221 (point B) and turning in a generally southeasterly direction for approximately 32 metres to grid reference ST 6479 6218 (point C) to a new line running from a junction with Hunstrete Lane at grid reference ST 6478 6234 (point D) and proceeding in a generally westerly direction for approximately 27 metres to a junction with the new line of Public Footpath BA15/27 at grid reference ST 6476 6234 (point G) and continuing in a generally west-southwesterly direction for approximately 153 metres to grid reference ST 6462 6228 (point F); and
- 2. that section of public footpath running from a junction with Hunstrete Lane and Public Footpath BA15/27 at grid reference ST 6478 6235 (point A) and proceeding in a generally westerly direction for approximately 91 metres to grid reference ST 6469 6233 (point E) and turning in a generally southwesterly direction for approximately 91 metres to grid reference ST 6462 6228 (point F) to a new line running from a junction with the new line of Public Footpath BA15/35 at grid reference ST 6476 6234 (point G) and proceeding in a generally south-southeasterly direction for approximately 100 metres to grid reference ST 6480 6225 (point H) and continuing in a generally southerly direction for approximately 72 metres to grid reference ST 6479 6218 (point C);

as shown on the order map.
