- running from a junction with Public Footpath (FP) BA25/14 at grid reference ST 7386 5837 (point B on the order map) and proceeding in a generally westerly direction for approx 50 metres to grid reference ST 7381 5838 (point D) to a line running from a junction with the new line of FP BA25/14 at ST 7385 5838 (point F) and proceeding in a generally westerly direction for approx 35 metres to ST 7381 5838 (point D);
- and
  - running from ST 7386 5838 (point A) and proceeding in a generally southerly direction for approx 6 metres to a junction with FP BA25/13 at ST 7386 5837 (point B) and continuing in a generally south-southwesterly direction for approx 125 metres to ST 7382 5826 (point C) to a line running from ST 7386 5838 (point A) and proceeding in a generally southwesterly direction for approx 5 metres to ST 7386 5838 (point E) and turning in a generally west-northwesterly direction for approx 12 metres to a junction with the new line of FP BA25/14 at ST 7385 5838 (point F) and turning in a generally south-southwesterly direction for approx 22 metres to ST 7383 5828 (point G) and turning in a generally southerly direction for approx 93 metres to ST 7382 5826 (point H) and turning in a generally southwesterly direction for approx 22 metres to ST 7382 5826 (point H) and turning in a generally southwesterly direction for approx 3 metres to ST 7382 5826 (point J) and turning in a generally southwesterly direction for approx 3 metres to ST 7382 5826 (point C)

as shown on the order map.

If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
