EMERGENCY CLOSURE BY NOTICE

SECTION 14(2) OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

(PUBLIC FOOTPATH BA2/5, RIVERPATH, BATHEASTON)

Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has temporarily introduced a path closure with immediate effect on the section of public footpath BA2/5 commencing from a junction with public footpaths BA2/3 and BA2/4 at ST 7747 6706 (Point A) and proceeding in a generally north easterly direction along the riverpath for approximately 610 metres to grid reference ST 7795 6738 (Point B).

This temporary closure is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road; namely, the riverbank has been undermined by river erosion. The closure has come into force with immediate effect and will be effective for up to 21 days.
