SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS ACT 1984

BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC BYWAYS BA12/34 & BA13/20, PIPEHOUSE LANE, FRESHFORD & HINTON CHARTERHOUSE) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023


Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has made an order to temporarily introduce a closure to the sections of public byways BA12/34 & BA13/20 commencing from Midford Road at grid reference ST 7632 6064 (point A on the Notice Plan) and proceeding in a generally south-easterly direction for approximately 1519 metres to a junction with public footpath BA13/14 and Pipehouse Lane at grid reference ST 7744 5991 (point B on the Notice Plan).

This order is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the right of way: namely, Bath & North East Somerset Council are carrying out works to repair the damaged surface. The Order will come into force on 8 January 2024 and will be effective for **four weeks**. The restriction may not be effected for the whole of the period but only for so long as is necessary to execute the works. This is anticipated to be for **one week**.
