BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH BA27/70, HIGH STREET, KEYNSHAM) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Public Footpath BA27/70 in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that all traffic in the said public footpath should be restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the footpath to facilitate the construction of social housing accommodation on behalf of H Mealing & Sons Limited.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

- 1. No person shall proceed in that length of Public Footpath BA27/70 commencing from grid reference ST 6532 6872 (point A on the Order Plan) and proceeding in a generally north-easterly direction for approximately 68 metres to grid reference ST 6536 6875 (point B on the Order Plan).
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
- 3. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any pedestrian requiring access to any premises situated on or adjacent to the public footpath, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the public footpath.
- 4. This order shall come into operation on 10 March 2025 and will be operative for a period of six months. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Public Footpath BA27/70, High Street, Keynsham) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2025.
