BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH BA26/20, BLACKACRE, WHITCHURCH)TEMPORARY **TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025**

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Public Footpath BA26/20 in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that all traffic in the said public footpath should be restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the footpath to facilitate renovation works on behalf of Bristol Water.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

- 1. No person shall proceed in that length of Public Footpath BA26/20 commencing from a junction with Public Footpath BA26/19 at grid reference ST 6083 6734 (point A on the Order Plan) and proceeding in a generally east-northeasterly direction for approximately 480 metres to a junction with Public Footpath BA26/4 at grid reference ST 6121 6748 (point B on the Order Plan).
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
- 3. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any pedestrian requiring access to any premises situated on or adjacent to the public footpath, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the public footpath.
- 4. This order shall come into operation on 8th April 2025 and will be operative until 15th August 2025. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Public Footpath BA26/20, Blackacre, Whitchurch) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2025.
