

# NOTICE OF INTENTION TO MAKE ORDER

## SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

### BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH BA27/30, MINSMERE ROAD, KEYNSHAM) (NO.2) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025

Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 intends to make an order the effect of which will be to temporarily introduce a closure to the section of Public Footpath BA27/30 commencing from grid reference ST 6645 6771 (point A on the Notice Plan) and proceeding in a generally east south-easterly direction for approximately 137 metres to grid reference ST 6657 6763 (point B on the Notice Plan).

This order is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the right of way: namely the applicant will be building 67 residential properties. The Order will come into force on 7<sup>th</sup> July 2025 and will be effective for six months.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTE: Minsmere Road – Hurn Lane – Manor Road – Public Footpath BA27/30. Vice Versa.
