(PUBLIC FOOTPATH BCTOW/3, BATHWICK HILL, BATH)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2026**

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Public Footpath BCTOW/3 in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that all traffic in the said public footpath should be restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the footpath: namely re-surfacing works.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

1. No person shall proceed in that length of Public Footpath BCTOW/3 commencing from a junction with Bathwick Hill at grid reference ST 7581 6491 (point A on the Order Plan) and proceeding in a generally southerly direction for approximately 437 metres to grid reference ST 7578 6448 (point B on the Order Plan).
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
3. This order shall come into operation on 7 April 2026 and will be operative until 19 June 2026. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Public Footpath BCTOW/3, Bathwick Hill, Bath) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2026.
