Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has temporarily introduced a path closure with immediate effect to that length of public footpath BA1/25 commencing from a junction with Public Footpath BA1/24 at grid reference ST 7776 6540 (Point A on the Notice Plan) and proceeding in a generally northeasterly direction for approximately 455 metres to a junction with Public Footpath BA1/27 at grid reference ST 7803 6575 (Point B on the Notice Plan).

This temporary closure is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public: namely, the danger caused by an uprooted tree which is at risk of falling onto the footpath. The closure has come into force with immediate effect and will be effective for 21 days.
