## EMERGENCY CLOSURE BY NOTICE SECTION 14(2) OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 (PUBLIC FOOTPATH BA27/23, KEYNSHAM)

Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has temporarily introduced a path closure with immediate effect on public footpath BA27/23 from a junction with Steel Mills Footpath at grid reference ST 6569 6775 (Point A) and proceedings in a generally southerly direction through a field adjacent to the River Chew for approximately 700 metres to a junction with Chewton Road at grid reference ST 6564 6706 (Point B).

This temporary closure is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road; namely, dangerous livestock needs to be removed from the field through which the public footpath runs.
