TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023**


Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Public Footpath (FP) BA21/9, Charmy Down, St Catherine in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that all pedestrian traffic in the said Public Footpath should be restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road to facilitate construction and landscaping works.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

1. No person shall proceed in:
 - a) section 1 of FP BA21/9 which runs between Charmydown Lodge and Charmydown Barn from grid reference ST 7670 6896 (point A on the Order Map) for approximately 9 metres in an easterly direction to its junction with section 2 of FP BA21/9 which runs between Charmydown Lodge and Charmydown Farm House at grid reference ST 7671 6896 (point B), continuing for approximately 30 metres in a northeasterly direction to grid reference ST 7673 9898 (point C) and
 - b) section 2 of FP BA21/9 from its junction with section 1 of FP BA21/9 at grid reference ST 7671 6896 (point B) for approximately 6 metres in a southwesterly direction to grid reference ST 7671 6896 (point D).
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
3. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any pedestrian requiring access to any premises situated on or adjacent to the Public Footpath, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the Public Footpath.
4. This order shall come into operation on 3rd March 2023 and will be operative for a period of 6 months. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Public Footpath BA21/9, Charmy Down, St Catherine) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2023.


