BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (CL24/107, COBBLERS WAY, WESTFIELD) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2019

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for public footpath CL24/107 in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that pedestrian traffic in the said public footpath should be restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road to facilitate the construction of 81 new dwellings on behalf of Oval Estates (St Peter's) Ltd.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

- 1. No person shall proceed in that length of the section of public footpath CL24/107 commencing from a junction with Wells Road at grid reference ST 6745 5403 and continuing in a generally southeasterly direction for approximately 550 metres to grid reference ST 6769 5372.
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
- 3. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any pedestrian requiring access to any premises situated on or adjacent to the public footpath, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the public footpath.
- 4. This order shall come into operation on 12th December 20109 and will be operative for a period of six months. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (CL24/107, Cobblers Way, Westfield) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2019.


