EMERGENCY CLOSURE BY NOTICE

SECTION 14(2) OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

(PUBLIC FOOTPATH BA3/3, RAILWAY BRIDGE, BATHFORD)

Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has temporarily introduced a path closure with immediate effect on that section of public footpath BA3/3 commencing from a junction with Box Road (A4) at grid reference ST 7979 6745 4and proceeding in a generally south-southwesterly direction for approximately 107 metres over a railway bridge to a junction with public footpath BA3/4 at grid reference ST 7983 6737.

This temporary closure is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road; namely, Network Rail are proposing to removal a fallen tree. The closure has come into force with immediate effect and will be effective for up to 21 days.
