## BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH BA19/25A, SUNNYSIDE VIEW, PEASEDOWN ST JOHN) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Public Footpath BA19/25A in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that pedestrian traffic in the said public footpath should be restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road to facilitate the laying of ducting on behalf of the Dodd Group Limited.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

- No person shall proceed in that length of Public Footpath BA19/25A commencing from grid reference ST 7023 5738 (point A on the Order Plan) and proceeding in a generally southerly direction for approximately 84 metres to a junction with Sunnyside View at grid reference ST 7024 5730 (point B on the Order Plan).
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
- 3. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any pedestrian requiring access to any premises situated on or adjacent to the Public Footpath, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the Public Footpath.
- 4. This order shall come into operation on 28<sup>th</sup> August 2023 and will be operative for a period of five days. The closure will only be effective during that period when signs stating 'Footpath Closed' are in place on site. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Public Footpath BA19/25A, Sunnyside View, Peasedown St John) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2023.




