BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY CL3/83, DUMPERS LANE, CHEW MAGNA) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2022

Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 intends to make an order, the effect of which will be to temporarily introduce a bridleway closure to the section of Public Bridleway CL3/83 from its junction with Dumpers Lane at grid reference ST 5734 6290 in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 80 metres to its junction with Public Footpath CL3/44/Crickback Lane at grid reference ST 5728 6294.

This order is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the right of way; namely, Bath & North East Somerset Council are proposing bridge replacement works. The Order will come into force on 9th January 2023 and will be effective for **6 WEEKS**. The restriction may not be effected for the whole of the period but only for so long as is necessary to execute the works. This is anticipated to be for 4 WEEKS. The closure will only be effective during the period when signs stating 'Bridleway Closed' are in place on site and only for so long as is necessary to execute the works.
