## **EMERGENCY CLOSURE BY NOTICE**

## SECTION 14 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Notice is given that Bath and North East Somerset Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has temporarily introduced a path closure with immediate effect on a section of public footpath CL4/29a, Chew Stoke from its junction with Breach Hill Lane at grid reference ST 5579 6124 in a generally northerly direction for approximately 42 metres to a field boundary at grid reference ST 5577 6127, as shown on the closure map.
