## BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH CL9/22, HOBB'S WALL, FARMBOROUGH) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2020

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Public Footpath CL9/22, Hobb's Wall, Farmborough in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that pedestrian traffic in the said Public Footpath should be restricted because of the likelihood of danger to the public, namely a sink hole of undetermined depth has appeared adjacent to the public footpath.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

- No person shall proceed in that length of public footpath CL9/22 commencing from a junction with public footpath CL9/24 at grid reference ST 6532 5992 (Point A on the Order Map) and proceeding in a generally easterly direction for approximately 315 metres to a junction with public footpath CL9/23 at grid reference ST 6563 5988 (Point B on the Order Map).
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
- 3. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any pedestrian requiring access to any premises situated on or adjacent to the Public Footpath, or to any other premises accessible by pedestrians from, and only from, the Public Footpath.
- 4. This order shall come into operation on 30th January 2020 and will be operative for a period of 6 months. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (Public Footpath CL9/22, Hobb's Wall, Farmborough) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2020.
