BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (BC62-4, SUMMER LANE, COMBE DOWN) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2019

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for BC62/4 in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that pedestrian traffic over the said footpath should be restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the road to facilitate drainage and refurbishment works on behalf of the Council.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:


- 1. No person shall proceed over that length of BC62/4 commencing from Summer Lane at grid reference ST 7622 6214 (point A on the Order Plan) and proceeding in a south-southeasterly direction for approximately 142 metres to the top of the steps at grid reference ST 7626 6201 (point B on the Order Plan).
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
- 3. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any pedestrian requiring access to any premises situated on or adjacent to the footpath, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the footpath.
- 4. This order shall come into operation on 9th December 2019 and will be operative for a period of 12 weeks. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset Council (BC62-4, Summer Lane, Combe Down) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2019.
