## BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC BYWAYS BA11/22 & BA20/18, MILL LANE, ENGLISHCOMBE) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024

Notice is given that the order made by Bath and North East Somerset Council on 18<sup>th</sup> April 2024 will be continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of his powers under section 15(5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The order will continue in force until the necessary remedial works have been completed or until 2 May 2025, whichever is the earlier.

The effect of which will be to continue to close **to all non-pedestrian users** the sections of Public Byways BA20/18 & BA11/22 commencing from a junction with Public Footpath BA20/14 at grid reference ST 6957 6154 (Point A on the Notice Plan) and proceeding in a generally south-easterly then north-easterly direction for approximately 650 metres to a junction with Public Footpath BA11/11 at grid reference ST 7006 6143 (Point B on the Notice Plan).

This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public: namely, the danger caused by a deep trench which has been cut down the middle of the byway by running water on the Englishcombe side of the Parish boundary, rendering passage unsafe for all users other than pedestrians.
