## BATH AND NORTH EAST SOMERSET COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH CL18/18, OLD TARNWELL, STANTON DREW) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2025

Bath and North East Somerset Council ("the Council") being the highway authority for Public Footpath CL18/18 in the County and District of Bath and North East Somerset is satisfied that pedestrian traffic in the said public footpath should be restricted because of the likelihood of danger to the public: namely the danger caused by a broken footbridge, which requires replacement before the section of public footpath can once again be used safely.

The Council in exercise of its powers under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order:

- 1. No person shall proceed in that length of Public Footpath CL18/18 commencing from the junction with Public Footpath CL18/19 at grid reference ST 6059 6279 (Point A on the Order Plan) and proceeding in a generally south-easterly direction for approximately 851 metres to the junction with Public Footpath CL18/20 at grid reference ST 6115 6218 (Point B on the Order Plan).
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply to any contractor necessarily proceeding to or from the said works.
- 3. This order shall come into operation on 26 June 2025 and will be operative for a period of six months. The Order may be cited as the Bath and North East Somerset (Public Footpath CL18/18, Old Tarnwell, Stanton Drew) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2025.
